

TOWNSHIP OF ROCHELLE PARK

ORDINANCE NO. #1063 - 13

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER
16 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF ROCHELLE ENTITLED "FIRST AID
AND EMERGENCY SQUAD**

WHEREAS, the Township of Rochelle Park Volunteer Ambulance Corps is controlled and regulated pursuant to Chapter 16 of the Township Code; and

WHEREAS, the officers of the Ambulance Corps, from time to time, review the regulations of the Municipality regarding their department and conduct discussions with the member of the Township Committee which is assigned by the Township Committee to be the Committee's representative to the Squad; and

WHEREAS, recently, such meetings have been conducted and the result of these meeting has been that the Ambulance Corps has recommended an additional change to Chapter 16 ; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has reviewed the proposed modifications to the Ordinance and agrees that it would be in the best interest of the Ambulance Corps as well as the Municipality to make such changes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Rochelle Park, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 16-5 (B)1 is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the followings:

(1) Be a resident of the Township of Rochelle Park or any Municipality within two (2) miles of the border of the Township of Rochelle Park, however, in the event that the member does not reside within Rochelle Park or within a two (2) mile radius of the Township of Rochelle Park, the member must agree to be stationed and remain at Ambulance Headquarters or within a two (2) mile radius of Ambulance Headquarters for the duration of his/her duty shift.

SECTION TWO: Repealer:

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

SECTION THREE: Severability:

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance, but shall be confined in its effects to the section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION FOUR: Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication and in the manner provided by law.
