

TOWNSHIP OF ROCHELLE PARK

ORDINANCE NO. 1055-13

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER
28 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF ROCHELLE PARK TO
INCORPORATE THE “RULES AND
REGULATIONS” OF THE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Township of Rochelle Park, in 2010, adopted an ordinance in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118 which designated an “appropriate authority”; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforementioned statute, the rules and regulations for the operation of the Police Department should be adopted by the “appropriate authority”; and

WHEREAS, the appropriate authority has now prepared and adopted the Rules and Regulations for the Rochelle Park Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has now determined that it would be in the best interest of the Township and the Department to ratify those rules and regulations and incorporate the same into the Code of the Township of Rochelle Park.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Rochelle Park, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 28-12 entitled RULES AND REGULATIONS of Department is hereby amended as follows:

A. Each member of the Police Department shall be presented with a copy of the printed rules and regulations of the Police Department. It shall be the members duty to follow the provisions of these rules and regulations and, where necessary, to enforce the provisions of these rules and regulations against other members of the Department.

B. The rules and regulations of the Department have been adopted by the “appropriate authority” and are hereby ratified and adopted.

C. Said rules and regulations shall be on file and available for inspection during business hours in the Office of the Chief of Police or the Municipal Clerk.

SECTION TWO: Repealer:

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

SECTION THREE: Severability:

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance, but shall be confined in its effects to the section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION FOUR: Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication and in the manner provided by law.
