

TOWNSHIP OF ROCHELLE PARK

ORDINANCE NO. 1087 - 15

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROCHELLE PARK, AND, SPECIFICALLY, TO AMEND THE TABLE OF ORGANIZATION IN THE ROCHELLE PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Section 28-1 of the Code of the Township of Rochelle Park provides for a table of organization within that department; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended, to the Township Committee, an amendment to that Table of Organization; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police of the Township of Rochelle Park has recommended, to the Township Committee, that the Table of Organization be amended in order to promote efficiency within the Department; and

WHEREAS, upon a review of the Police Chief's recommendation, the Township Administrator has agreed with that recommendation and has also recommended the acceptance of the proposed amendment; and

WHEREAS, this amendment would result in increasing the maximum number of Lieutenants permitted pursuant to ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Rochelle Park, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 28-1 entitled **Composition of Department; Temporary Employees, Compensation** is hereby amended as follows:

A. The Police Department of the Township of Rochelle Park is hereby established to consist of the following officers:

- (1) One (1) Chief of Police
- (2) One (1) Captain of Police
- (3) Up to a maximum of four (4) Lieutenants

- (4) Up to a maximum of five (5) Sergeants
- (5) UP to a maximum of fourteen (14) patrol officers

SECTION TWO: Repealer:

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

SECTION THREE: Severability:

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance, but shall be confined in its effects to the section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION FOUR: Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication and in the manner provided by law.
