

**TOWNSHIP OF ROCHELLE PARK**

**ORDINANCE NO. 1007 - 09**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 112 OF THE CODE OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF ROCHELLE PARK ENTITLED  
“MANDATORY RECYCLING”**

**WHEREAS,** the Township of Rochelle Park has established a program of Mandatory Recycling for commercial and residential properties; and

**WHEREAS,** recently, the Bergen County Utilities Authority has amended its regulations in order to designate certain materials that must be the subject of Mandatory Recycling; and

**WHEREAS,** in order to clarify the articles which must be recycled, it has become necessary to adopt an amendment to the Mandatory Recycling Ordinance of the Township in order to specify those articles which must be recycled in both the commercial and residential sectors.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED,** by the Township Committee of the Township of Rochelle Park, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** Section 112-13.1 is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

**SECTION TWO.**            **Repealer:**

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

**SECTION THREE:**        **Severability:**

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance, but shall be confined in its effects to the section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION FOUR:**        **Effective Date:**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication and in the manner provided by law.
